
- Nature conservation grazing since the 1980s
- 1500 ha grazing area
- 1000 cattle
- 80 horses

Characteristics of nature conservation grazing

- Large areas
- Year-round grazing
- Depending on the productivity of the sites 0.5 – 0.2 livestock units per ha
- No supplementary feeding
- No fertilizers / no herbicides
- Animals can reach all vegetation structures (mound hedge, forests, water)



Farmed sites



- 500 ha grazed
- 85 suckler cows + bulls + calves
- 25 konik mares, 15 stallions + calves

- 300 ha grazed
- 50 suckler cows
- Konik herd only mares
