




Three types of land-use in dairy farming Netherlands, 0 common land




Decrease of HNV farmland due to agricultural intensification




Result: only 15% of mean species abundance left

New business models to 'reward' positive externalities of HNV farming



2016: Agricultural Collectives in NL



AIMS

- To conserve and improve 67 key species of mammals, birds, amfibians, reptiles, butterflies and dragonflies that prevail on farmland
- 2. Reduce overhead costs
- 3. More autonomy to farmers to achieve goals in areas with ecological potential
- 4. Only contracts with collectives (39)
- Farmers, nature conservation organisations & citizens as members of collectives
- 6. Collectives make proposal
- 7. Subsidy as incentive for new business model
- 8. Budget: Euro 60 million/year

Citizens' Proposal KingME 2018 & Iniciativa Comunales

- 1. Participatory democracy. Help us to develop a European citizen manifesto on Biocultural Diversity. Rural Parliament in Brussels in 2018?
- 2. Landscape Commons as heritage for future generations. Strengthen participatory governance of commons & collectives for the joy of future generations.
- 3. KingME&U Commons Lab. Participate in (on-line) exchange programmes on commons & collectives
- 4. Market failures & EU Policy. Work with us to ensure that the new CAP values positive externalities of commons, collectives, agro-ecology and nature-inclusive farming and puts a price on negative externalities of industrial farming.

Options:

- Can we join with EFNCP to make a joint booklet on commons, history, governance + art & culture (youth/artists) as inspiration for HNV farming?
- Work jointly towards Travelling festival in 2018 to celebrate diversity?
- Team up to influence CAP?

Joint Interreg proposal 2017-2020?:

Not CAP! Growth, jobs, biodiversity, ES, bio-based ec

Stakeholders work with public authorities to improve regional ERDF policies for biodiversity and Ecosystem Services through new cooperative models such as collectives and commons.
